



Frederick County Beekeeping Association 2016 Beginner's Beekeeping Short Course

The Frederick County Beekeeping Association (FCBA) is offering a beekeeping course for beginners covering the basics in order to prepare the prospective beekeeper to establish and maintain honeybees.

Traditionally, beekeeping associations offer courses in the winter months so that students are better able to order bees and equipment before Spring. Our 3-day course will be held on consecutive Saturdays — Jan. 9, Jan. 16 and Jan. 23, 2016 (Snow date, January 30th), from 9am-3pm at the:

In addition to these three lecture/demonstration days, there will also be a Saturday Field Day/Pot Luck Picnic later in the Spring where we'll cover more course material, and we'll work with bees and hives. (Date and location TBD).

For the three January classes, we encourage you to bring a bag lunch and mingle with beekeepers and students between the morning and afternoon sessions. Alternatively, fast food places are nearby. Beverages and snacks will be provided.

The cost for the course is \$70 per person for the first adult and \$45 per additional adult in the same family, if any. Family members ages 12 to 17 are \$30 per person. (The minimum age to attend this course is 12 years.) Course fee includes a 1 year free membership in FCBA!

There will be one set of materials per family including "The Beekeepers Handbook", 4th ed. (by Diana Sammataro and Alphonse Avitabile) which covers the basics of beginning beekeeping for our area. You will also get a binder with lecture outlines, printouts of relevant materials and space for note taking.

This course and FCBA general meetings (normally held the first Wednesday of each month at the USDA Bldg., 69 Thomas Johnson Dr., Frederick, MD) are great places to meet and discuss honeybees and beekeeping with other local beekeepers including vendors. Check out the FCBA website at:
