

Frederick County Beekeeping Association 2024 Beekeeping Course for Beginners

The Frederick County Beekeeping Association (FCBA) is offering a beekeeping course for beginners covering the basics in order to prepare would-be beekeepers to establish and maintain honeybee colonies. Registration is restricted to those who have not taken this course in the past.

Traditionally, beekeeping associations offer courses in the winter months so that students are better able to order bees and equipment before Spring. Our 3-day course will be held on consecutive Saturdays in January 2023 (Jan. 13, Jan. 20, and Jan. 27 (snow date, February 3rd)), from 9 am-3 pm at the:

In addition to these three lecture/demonstration days, there will also be a Saturday Field Day in a local apiary later in the Spring where we'll work with bees and hives. (Date and location TBD).

Be sure to attend all classes. We encourage you to bring a bag lunch and mingle with beekeepers and students during breaks and between the morning and afternoon sessions. Alternatively, fast food places are nearby. Beverages and snacks will be provided. Vendors of beekeeping supplies will be present on the 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} day of class. This is a great opportunity to discuss your bee and beekeeping equipment needs with the experts and to make on-site purchases as needed.

The cost for the course is \$90 per person for the first adult and \$80 for a maximum of one additional person age 16 years or older.

Drawings for door prizes will be held throughout each day. In addition, raffle tickets will be for sale for some very nice beekeeping products. Raffle drawings will be at the end of the last day of class at which time Course Completion Certificates will also be presented. Please be sure to attend all days of class.

- To better familiarize you with much of what will be covered, each family group should obtain their own copy of "Beekeeping for Dummies 5th ed." by Howland Blackiston which covers the basics of beginning beekeeping. Please read this book before class begins.
- Each student will get a 3-ring binder with lecture outlines, printouts of relevant materials, and space for taking notes.
- The course fee also includes a one-year free membership in FCBA (for new members only).
